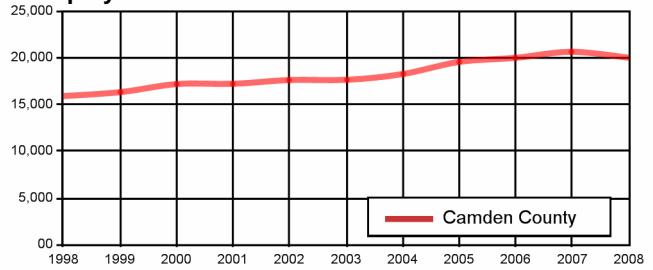

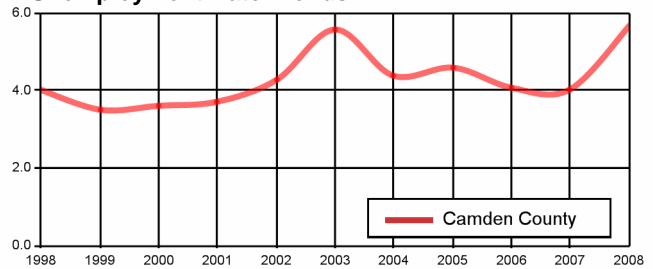

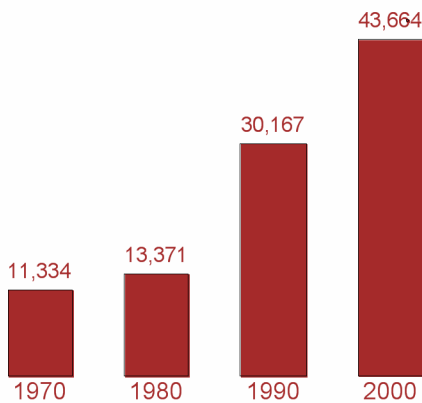

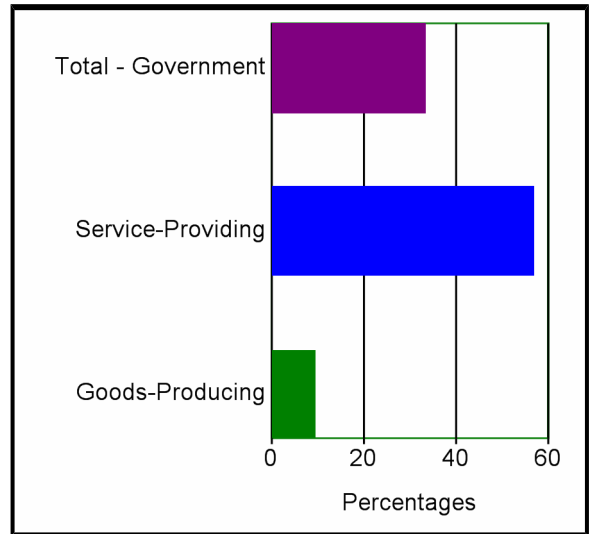
## Camden Per Capita Income
