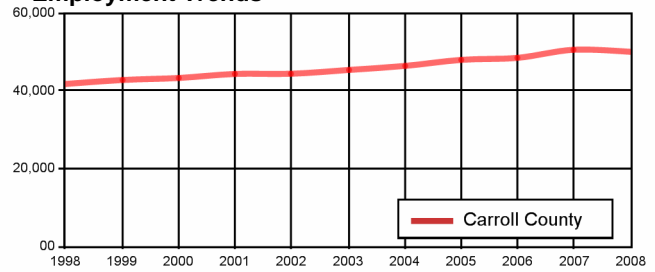

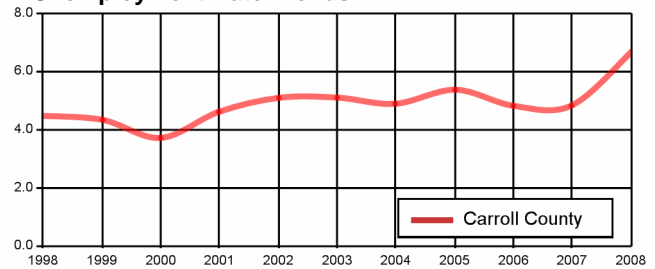

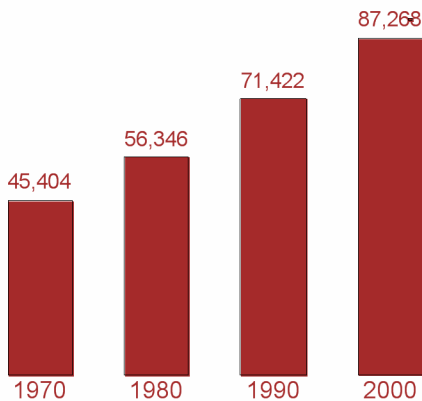
Employment Trends

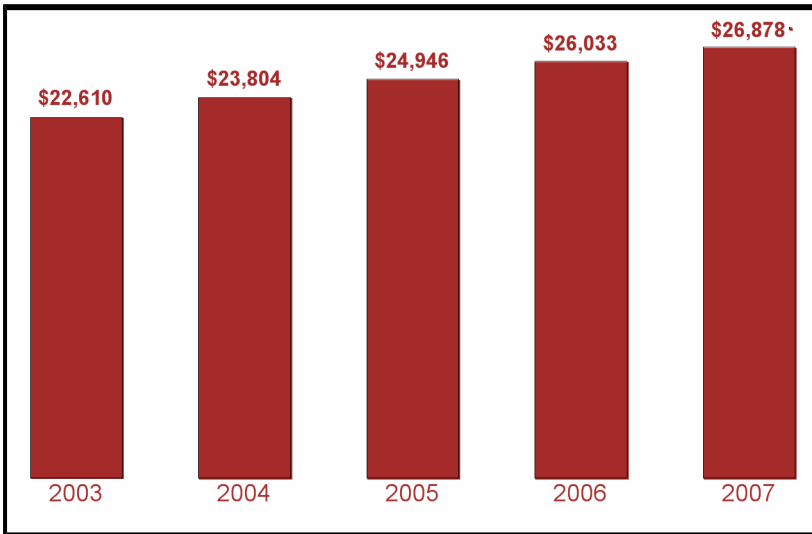

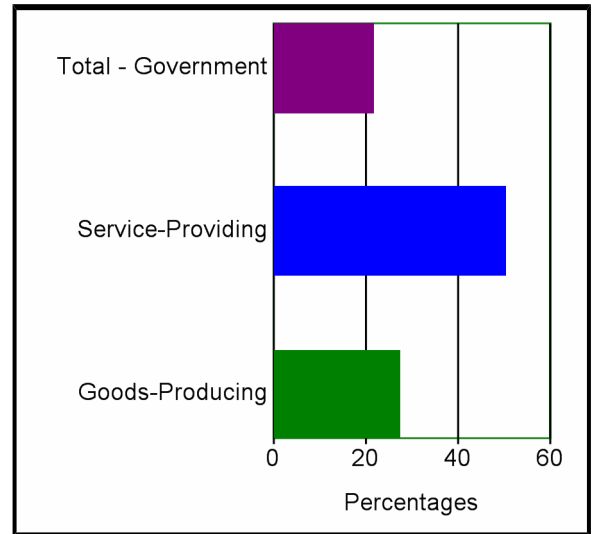
Carroll Per Capita Income
