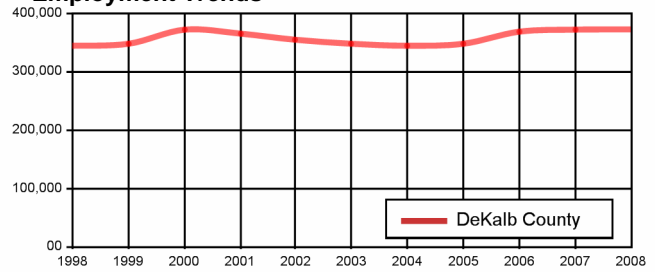

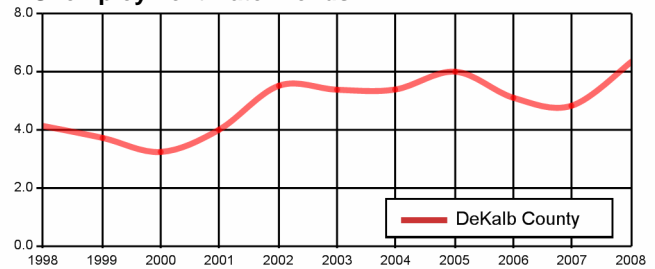

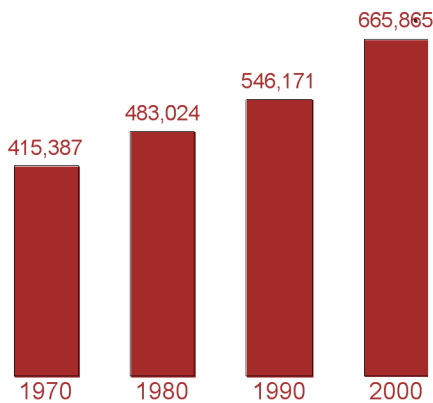
Employment Trends

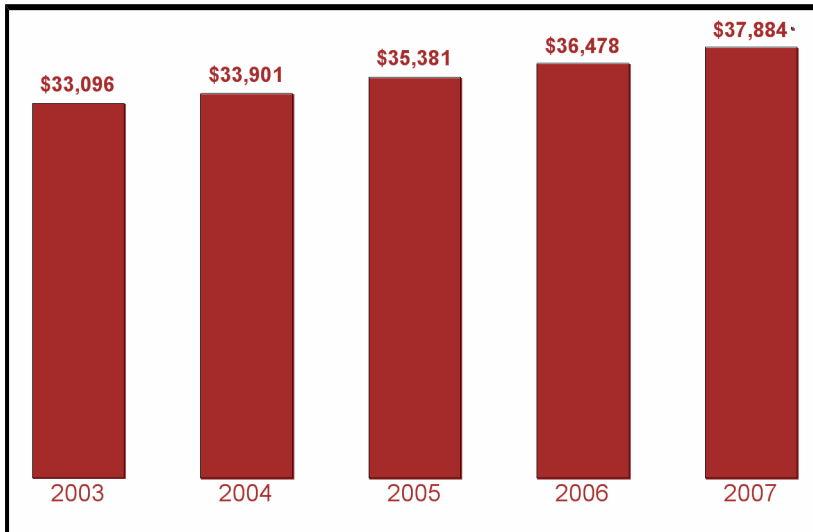

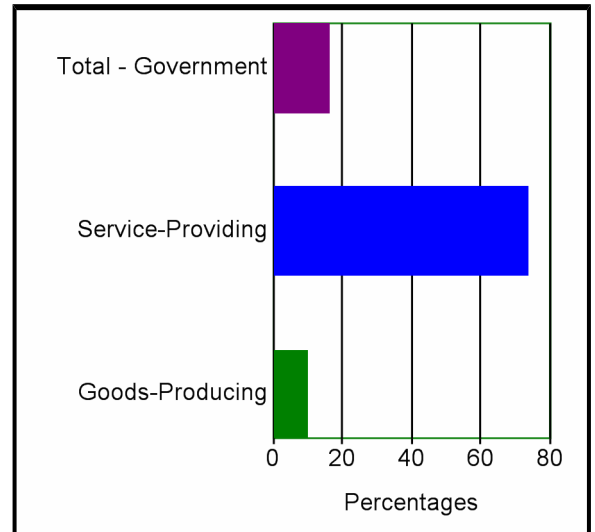
DeKalb Per Capita Income
