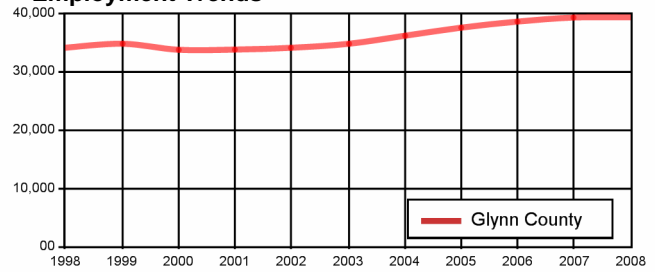

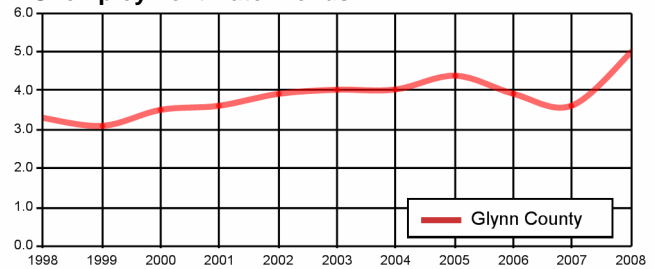

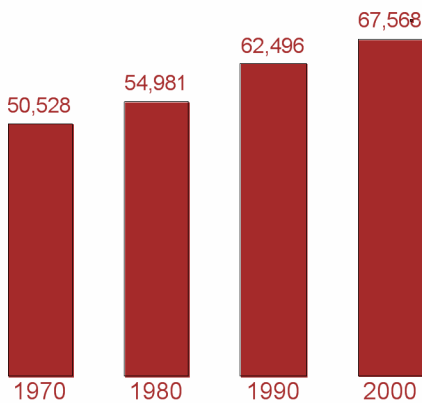
Employment Trends

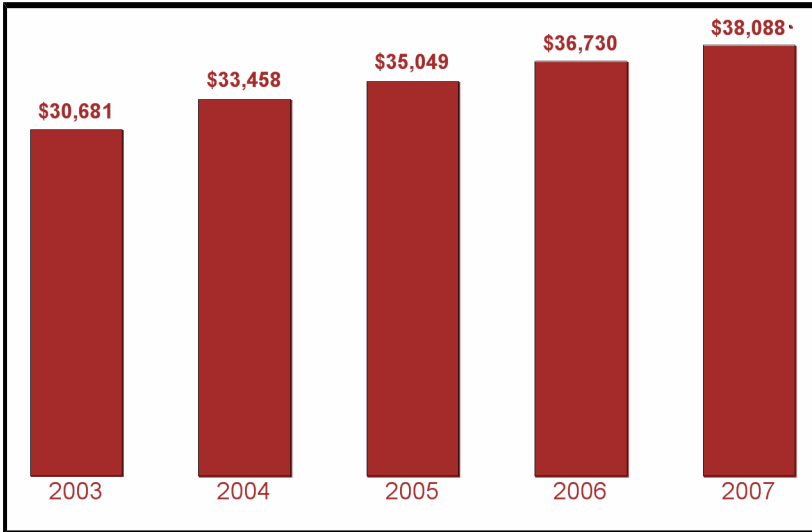

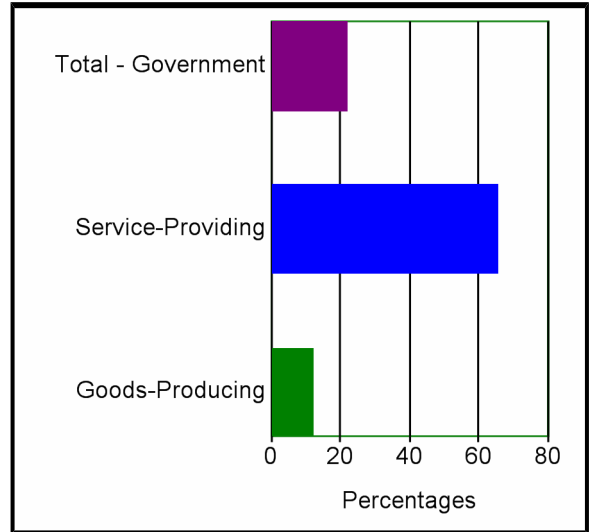
Glynn Per Capita Income
