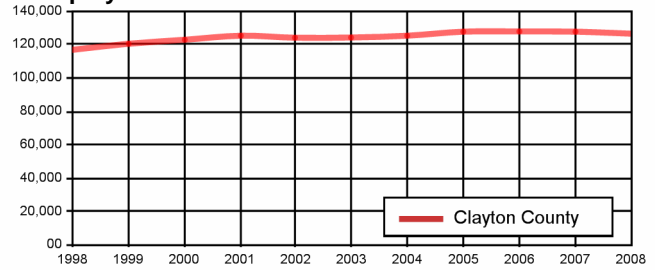

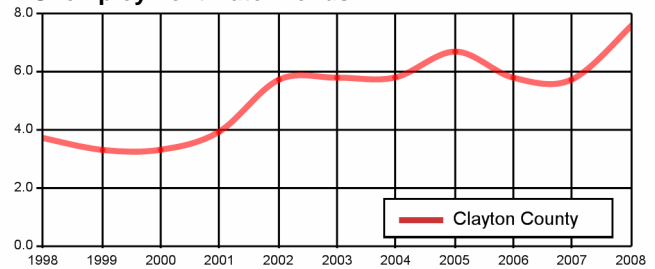

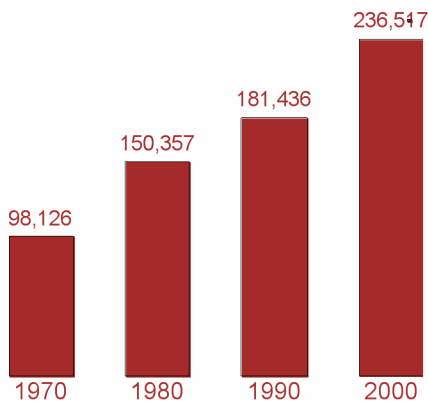
Employment Trends

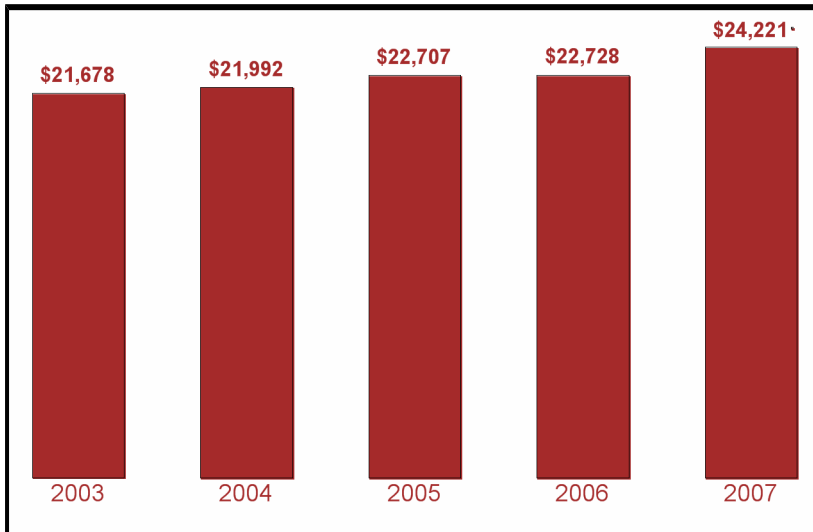

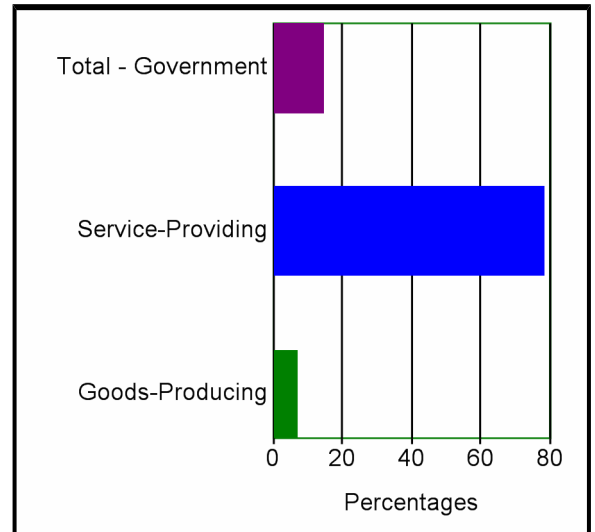
Clayton Per Capita Income
